Philip Moore, a senior at Christian Brothers College High School, has been named a 2011 National Scholar by the Horatio Alger Association. Only 104 scholarships were awarded nationwide from a field of more than 3,800 applicants. CBC's class leader in Christian service hours, Philip's volunteerism includes helping at soup kitchens and as a mentor to younger students. He is active in sports, the student newspaper and social justice clubs and is a member of the CBC National Honor Society.
